- Allow them to help pass the offering plate down their row

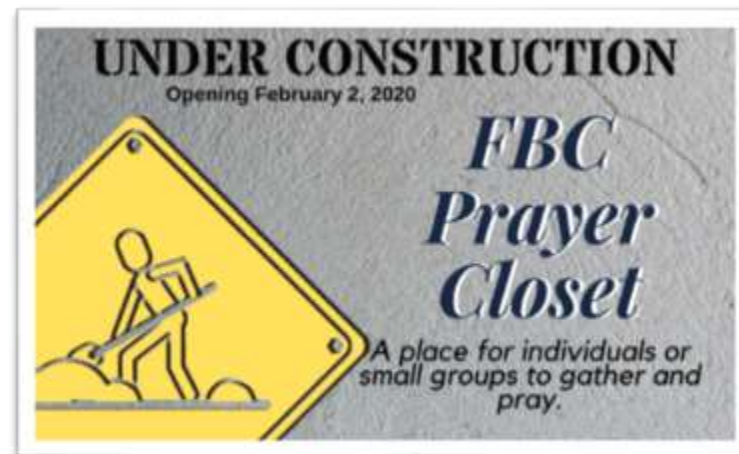
